Terms and Conditions

- 1. **Stall Size** Each stall area is 2m x 2m in size, please ensure that your goods fit within this space. Your area will be designated to you on arrival. We will have event volunteers on the day making sure stalls are set up accordingly and there is enough room in between stalls holders for people to walk through.
- 2. **What can you bring for your stall set up –** No Gazebo's allowed however you can bring a fold out table up to 1.8m in size, clothing rack, suitcase or mat, foldout chair to sit on as long as everything fits within your 2m x 2m area.
 - **Cash till –** collection of funds is the responsibility of the individual, please bring your own cash till with change or bank transfers can also be done on the day.
 - Outdoor event Please remember this is an outdoor event so It is the responsibility of
 individuals to ensure they have appropriate sun protection including, hat, umbrella,
 sunscreen and water.
- 3. What can you bring to sell Items that can be brought to sell include anything in your wardrobe. This can include, clothing, books, bric & brac and clothing accessories ie shoes, belts, handbags etc.
 - -The only items that aren't covered under the public liability insurance is **baby and children's clothing** so please avoid these items. Only Size 6 and up adult clothing is covered.
- 4. **Arrivals and Departures-** On time arrival is essential, please make sure you arrive before 7.30am. All Wardrobe Holders must have their names ticked off by the advertised start time of the event. Bump in will open 1.5 hours before the event at 6.00am. Please just give us a call and let us know you're running late. No Wardrobe Holders are to start packing up before the advertised closing time of the event of 12pm, please make sure you're able to commit to the end of the event time of 12pm.



Parking for Wardrobe Holders – No cars are permitted on the Square; parking is located at the Court house carpark on James street or street parking on Kent Street is also an option. We will have event volunteers on the day to help with bump in and out.

- 5. **Logan City Council / Beenleigh Wardrobe Rummage takes no responsibility** for the safe keeping of personal property of stallholders or rummagers while at the event. The security of your takings, goods and personal items is your own responsibility.
- 6.
